OWLS Office Move

The moving project is well underway. We are meeting with Outagamie County Maintenance Supervisor Paul Farrell weekly to monitor progress on the Brewster Street building.

We have had a meeting with VPI to discuss utilities and shared services such as snow removal, janitorial, pest control, and security and fire monitoring.
