Under administrative supervision, the Youth Services Librarian directs the activities of children's and young adult services and assumes operational responsibilities for the library in the absence of the Director and Technical Services Librarian. The successful candidate will have a strong commitment to providing quality public service and the desire to work in a collaborative, team environment.

The position requires a bachelor's degree, with a Master's of Library Science preferred. Management and supervisory responsibility or two years of progressively more responsible library management experience preferred. Past experience may be considered as an alternative to other requirements. This position is 40 hours per week with some possible evening and weekend hours. The salary ranges from 33,592-45,448, depending on qualifications, and excellent fringe benefits.
