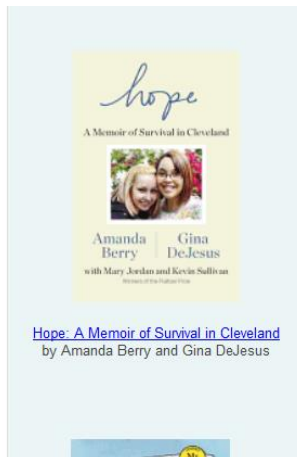
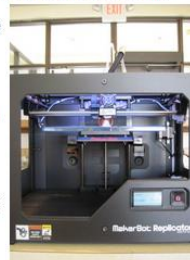

3D Printer at the Library

The library has purchased a 3D printer and scanner. This exciting acquisition is a part of a Maker Box program with several area libraries creating boxes of equipment that will be shared amongst the libraries and will allow hands on opportunities to make and learn. Other libraries purchased canning equipment, sewing machines, Raspberry Pi computers and Makey Makeys, and sound recording equipment to be included in their Maker Box. These boxes were made possible by Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds, awarded to the Department of Public Instruction by the Federal Institute of Museum and Library Services.
