

The best program is simply to have the 3D Printer sitting out on the counter and have it working. The lights, movement and sound of the machine really attract attention. Be prepared to answer questions about what it is and how it works. We have also found it useful to have examples of our prints out for people to handle, and photos of practical uses of 3D printing.
